10 Days in Zanzibar, The Spice Island

Step into the heart of Stone Town, where centuries of Swahili, Arab, and European influences echo through carved doors, spice-scented alleys, and historic landmarks. As the sun sets, Forodhani Gardens comes alive with sizzling street food—Zanzibar pizza, seafood skewers, and swahili food / fresh sugarcane juice: an unforgettable taste of island life.

Journey beyond the city to the island's natural wonders: wander fragrant spice farms, sail on a Safari Blue dhow across turquoise waters, and snorkel the vibrant reefs of Mnemba Atoll.

Encounter giant Aldabra tortoises on Prison Island, marvel at rare Red Colobus monkeys in Jozani Forest, and step into the tropical sanctuary of the Zanzibar Butterfly Centre, alive with color and conservation.

Along the coast, relax on the powder-white sands of Nungwi and Kendwa, or head south to Kizimkazi village for dolphin tours and authentic glimpses of traditional life. In Paje and Jambiani, meet the inspiring seaweed women farmers, whose sustainable livelihoods transform seaweed into food, cosmetics, and empowerment.

- Balloon safari: Float silently above Ruaha's endless savannah at sunrise, watching herds of elephants, giraffes, and lions from a breathtaking bird's-eye view, with a champagne bush breakfast in the heart of the wilderness.
- Unwind at the lodge with poolside serenity, spa indulgence, or a photography workshop. Take a sunset drive along the Ruaha River, where hippos, crocodiles, and dazzling skies create the perfect backdrop.
- Conservation & community impact: Meet rangers and community scouts to learn about anti-poaching efforts and Ruaha's vital role in protecting endangered species.
